



Sight Word Game

**This is a great center game for kids
to practice vocabulary and sight words!**

The template is blank so the teacher can customize it with words he or she may be currently studying. If you are using it for vocabulary you can alter the game by having students give a definition of the word, rather than spelling the word.

Suggestions:

Laminate it and write words in with a permanent marker.

Materials needed

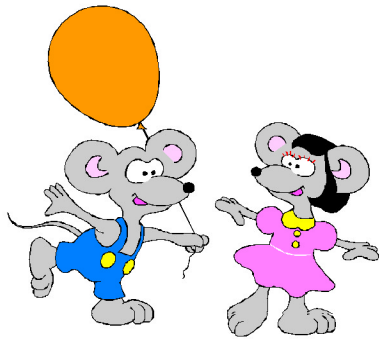

Small whiteboard or paper to keep track of points.

Directions

1. Decide who goes first.
2. The first player rolls the dice and moves that number of spaces.
3. At that space say the word and the spell word.
4. Then it is the second player's turn.
5. Play the game until a player reaches the last word.
6. Play at least five rounds. Give a point to the player that wins the round. At the end of all the rounds, add up all the points to see who won.
