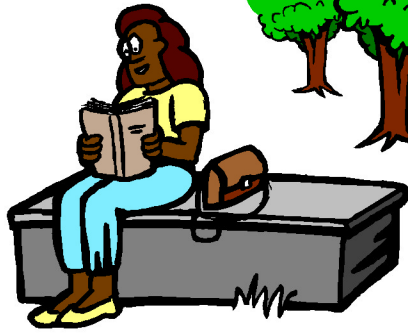
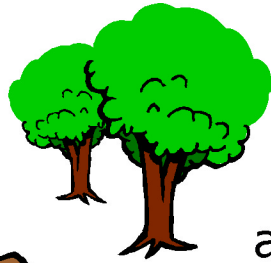
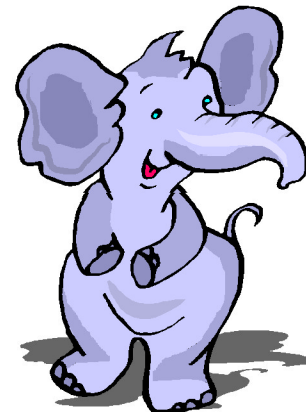
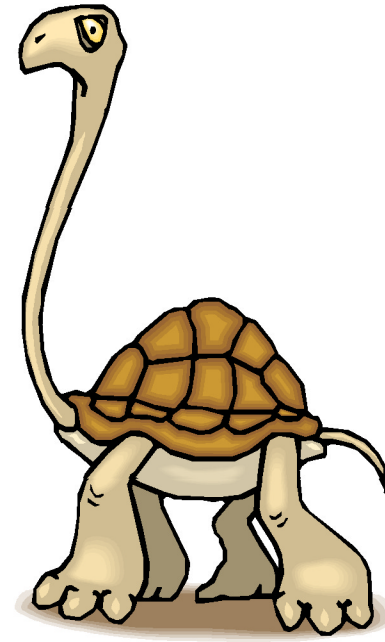


STATE OF BEING VERBS
