



# Identifying Coins

## Dimes & Quarters

### Dime

Front



Back



= 10¢

A dime equals 10¢

and is counted by tens (10,20,30,40...), it is silver in color and has a rough edge.

It takes 2 nickels or 10 pennies to make 1 dime.

A dime is smaller in size than a nickel and a penny.

### Quarter

Front

= 25¢

A quarter equals 25¢

and is counted by twenty-five (25,50,75...) It is silver in color and has a rough edge.

It takes 25 pennies or 5 nickels to make 1 quarter. 2 dimes and 1 nickel also make 1 quarter.

It is larger in size than a penny, nickel and dime.

If something costs 25¢, there are many ways to pay for it.
