Graphing Directions

Distribute one or two eyes to each student. Students cut and color their color on the eye(s). Make a graph using butcher paper and have students tape their eye color under the correct column. Display this in the classroom for students. Students can also make their own graph after the class graph has been made.

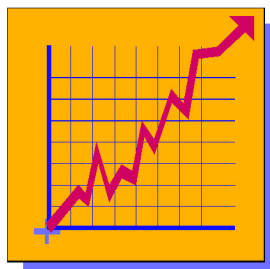
As questions such as:
