

Y as a Vowel

Y is a SPY

Y makes a different sound at the END of a word then it does at the BEGINNING of a word.

For Example: Yellow
Day



The story of SPY Y

Y the spy is a special vowel detective and wears a spy hat. She can change her sound according to the vowel she is helping. When she is near an **a**, she usually says the **long a sound (day)**. When she is at the **end of a shorter word**, she usually makes the **long i sound (spy and my)**. When **y** is at the **end of a longer word**, she usually makes the **long e sound (bunny and sunny)**. When she is near an **o**, it changes her sound to **oy (boy and toy)**.
