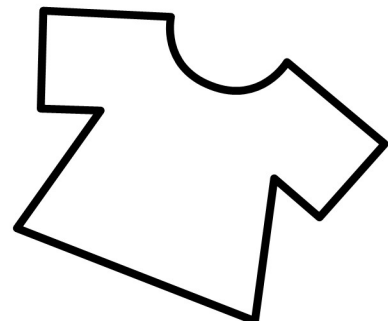
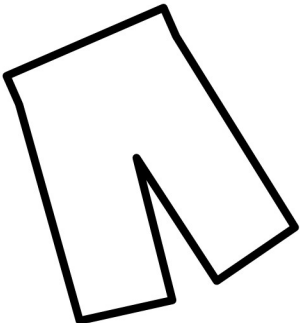
This is a book report made fun.

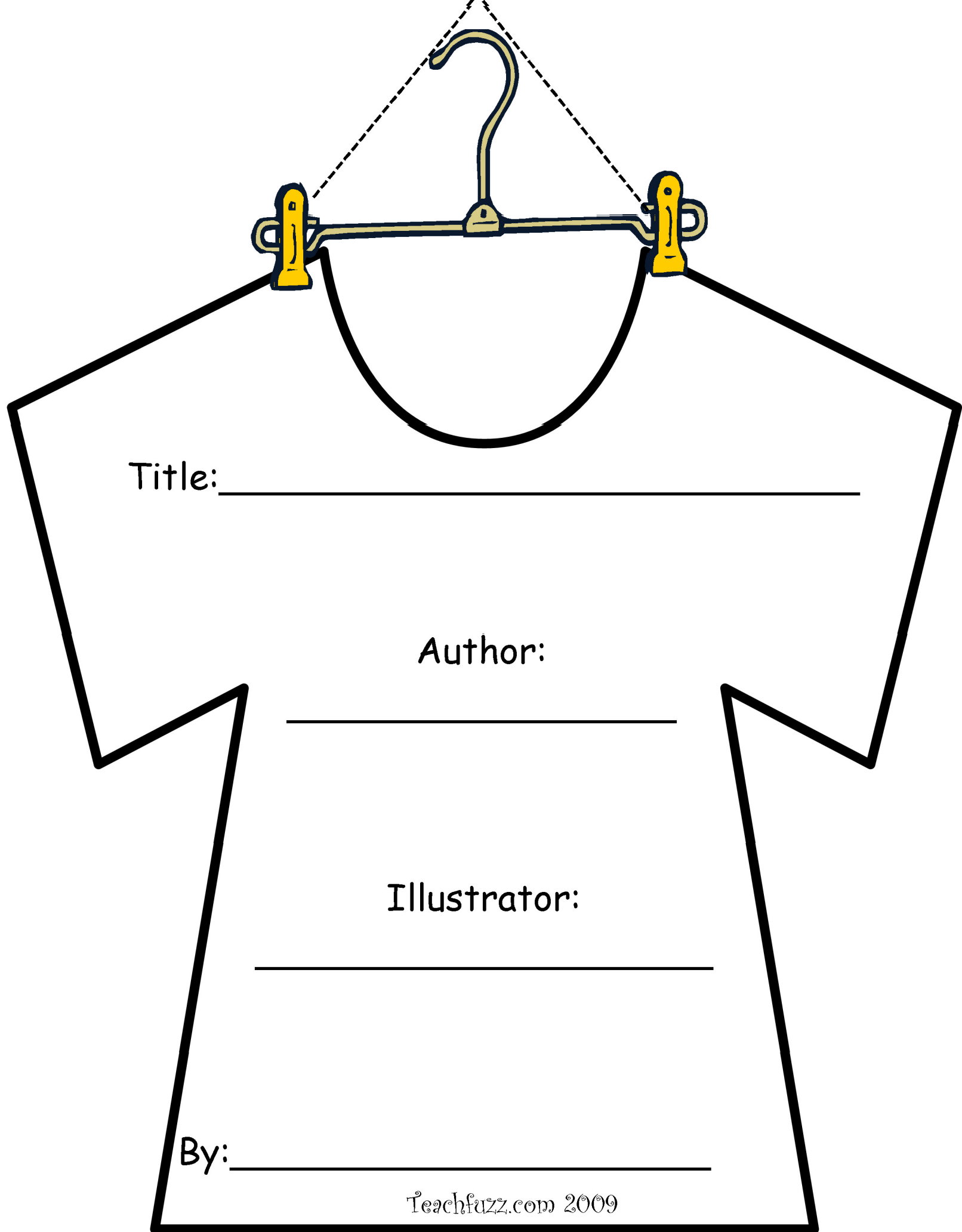
Teachers can use all the pages or use limited pages depending on grade level and ability.

Students may make the bar as long as they want. They can hang the clothes in pairs, individually, or stack all the clothes together by gluing the hangers to the clothing bar.



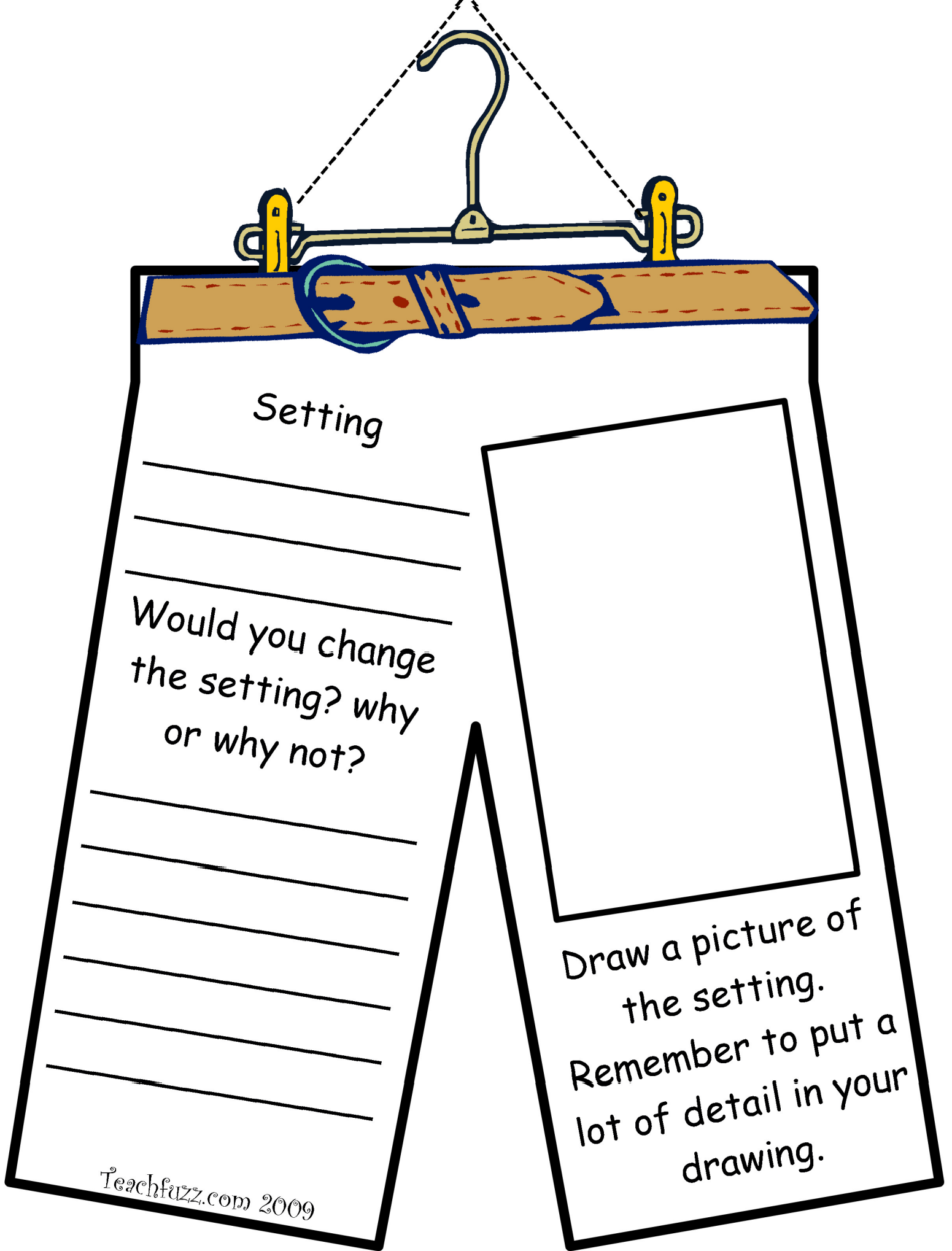

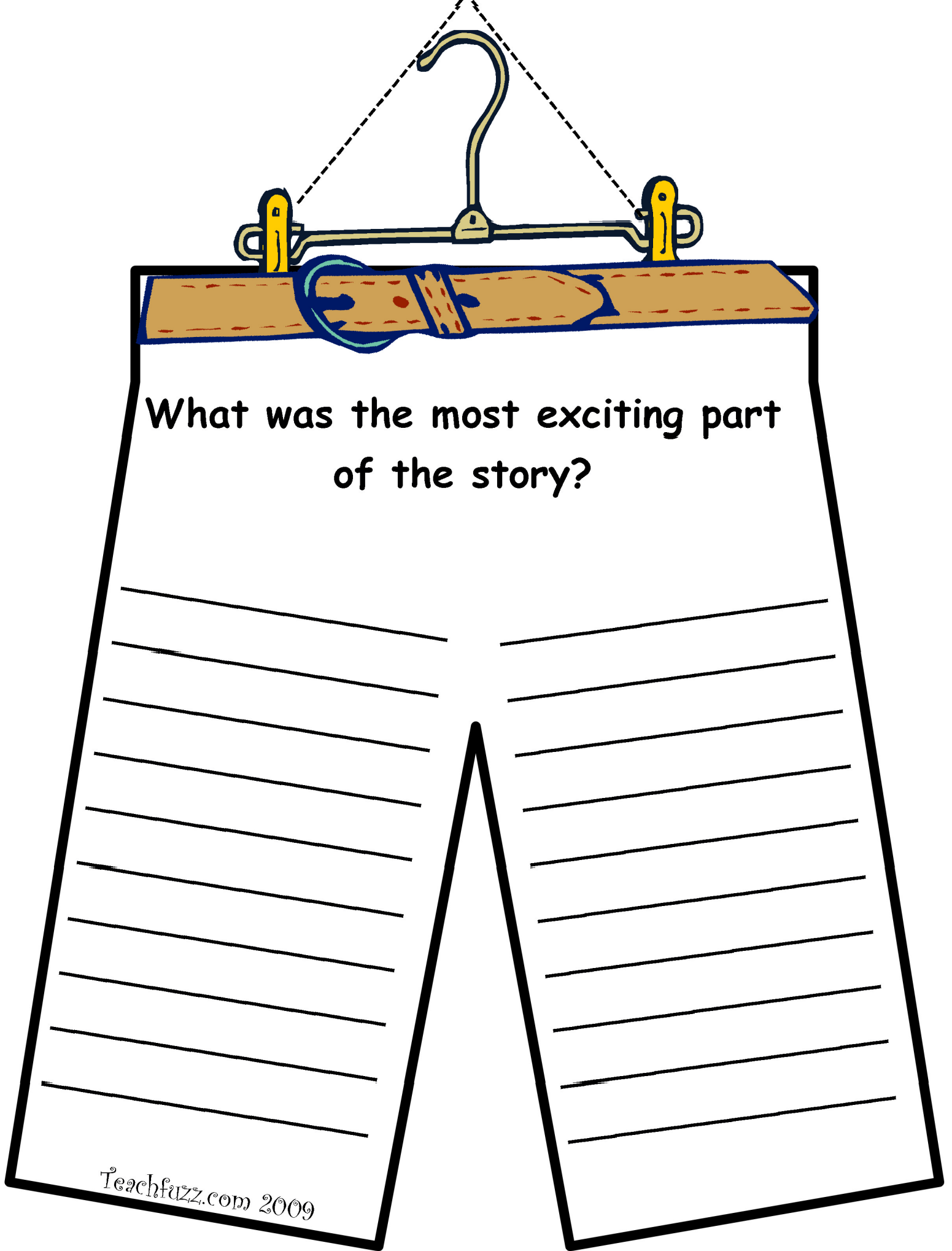


Draw a picture of the setting. Remember to put a lot of detail in your drawing.

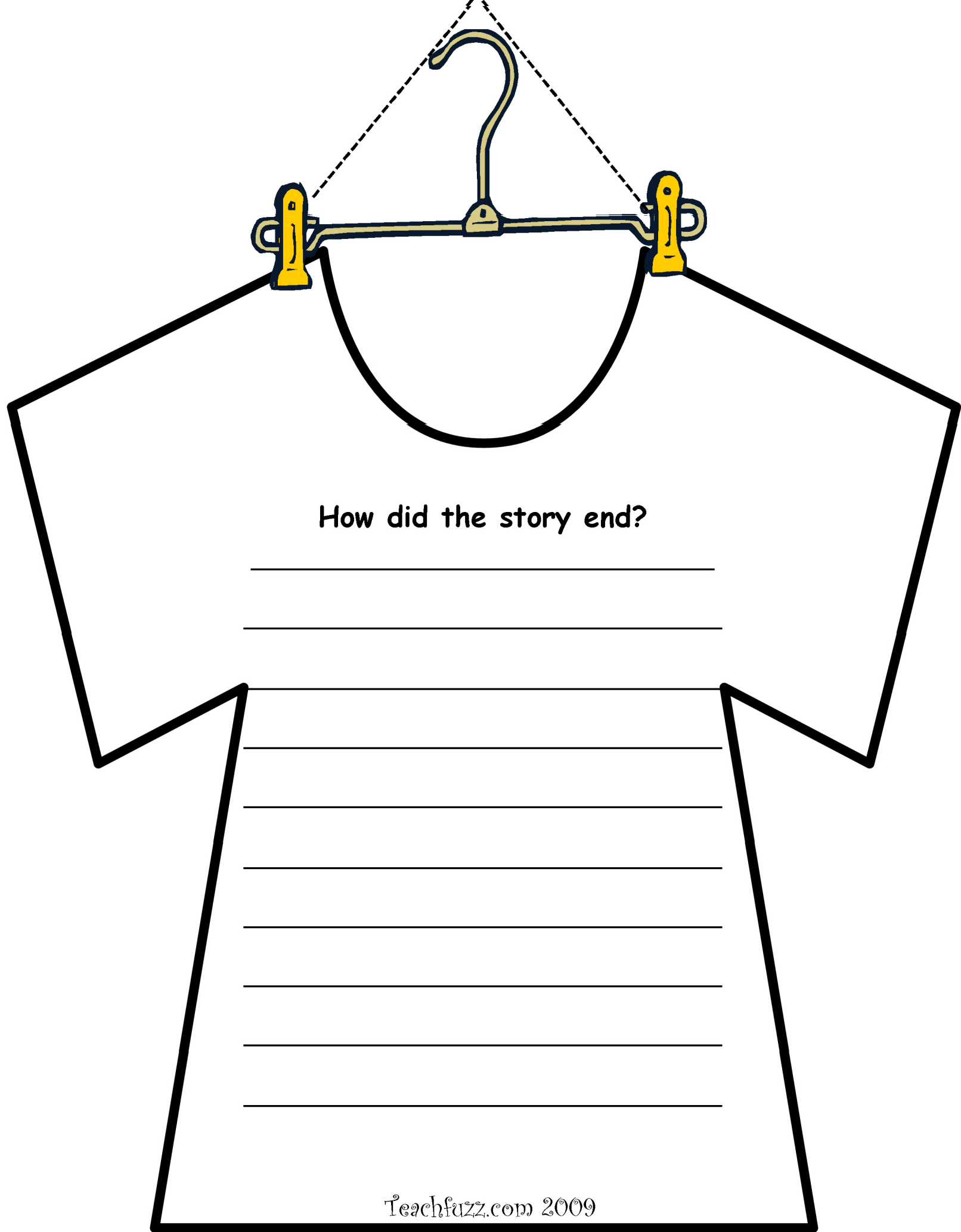

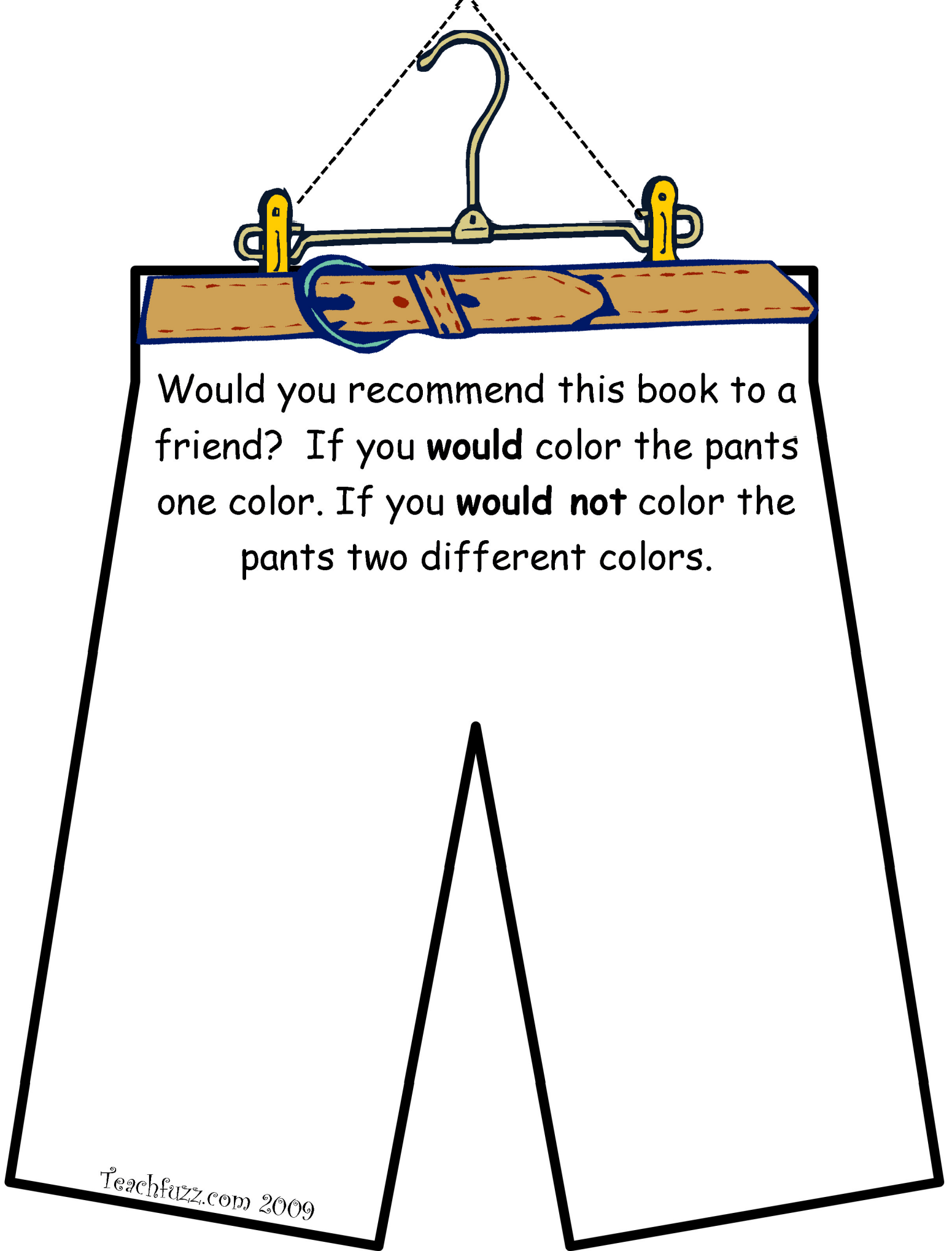
