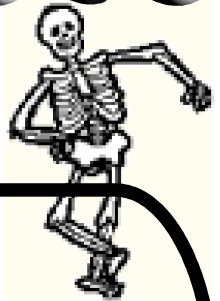
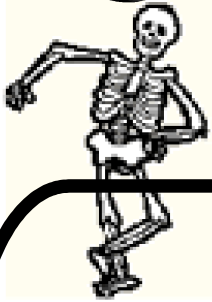


Skeleton Facts

ligaments.

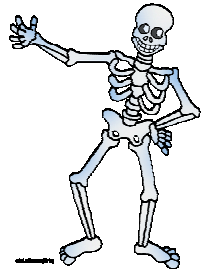
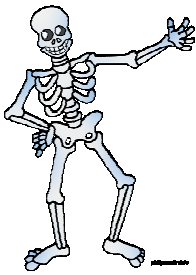
Your joints are lined with cartilage. Cartilage acts like a cushion, to

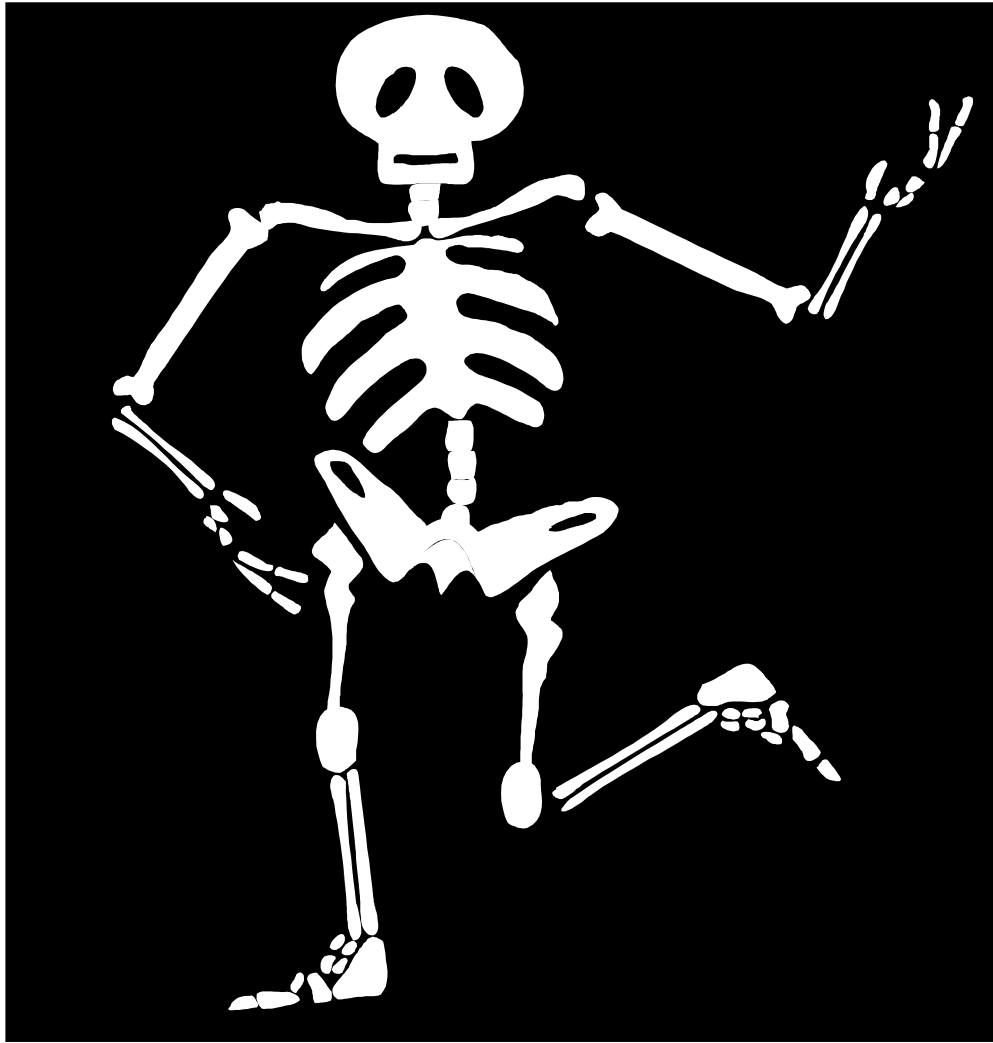


Cartilage acts as a cushion so your bones do not rub together.
