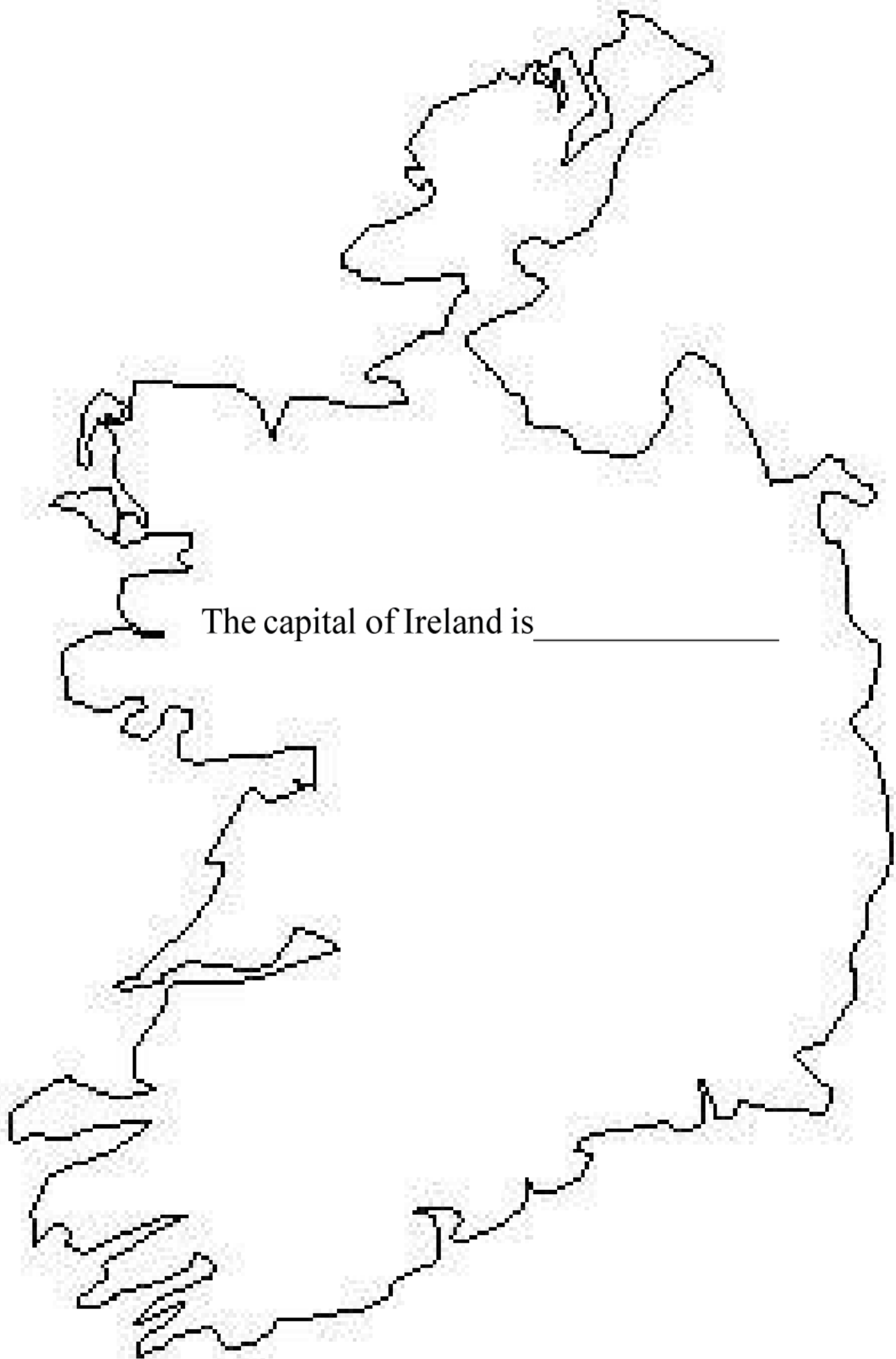



Interesting Ireland Facts

- Ireland gained its independence in 1922






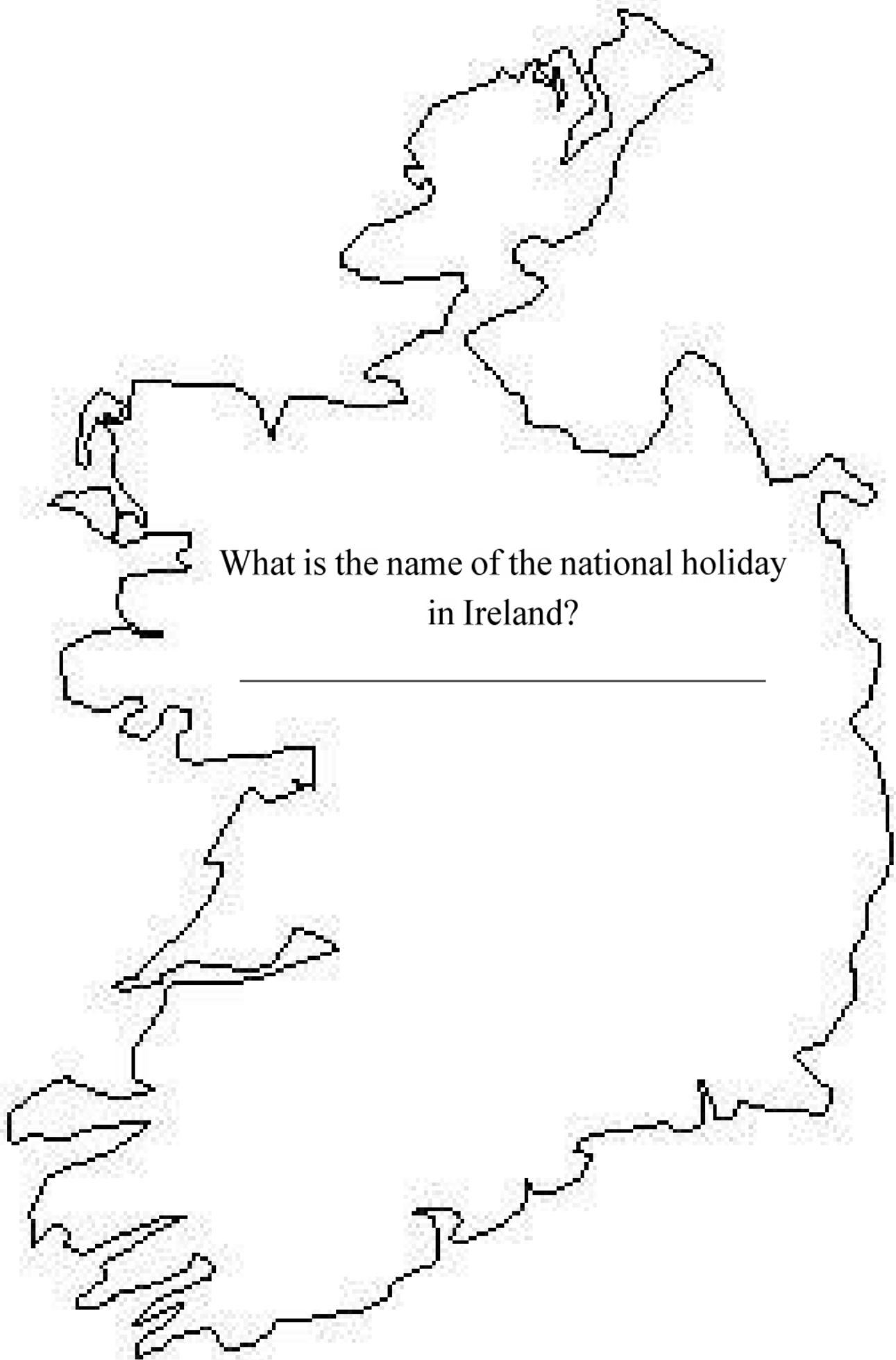

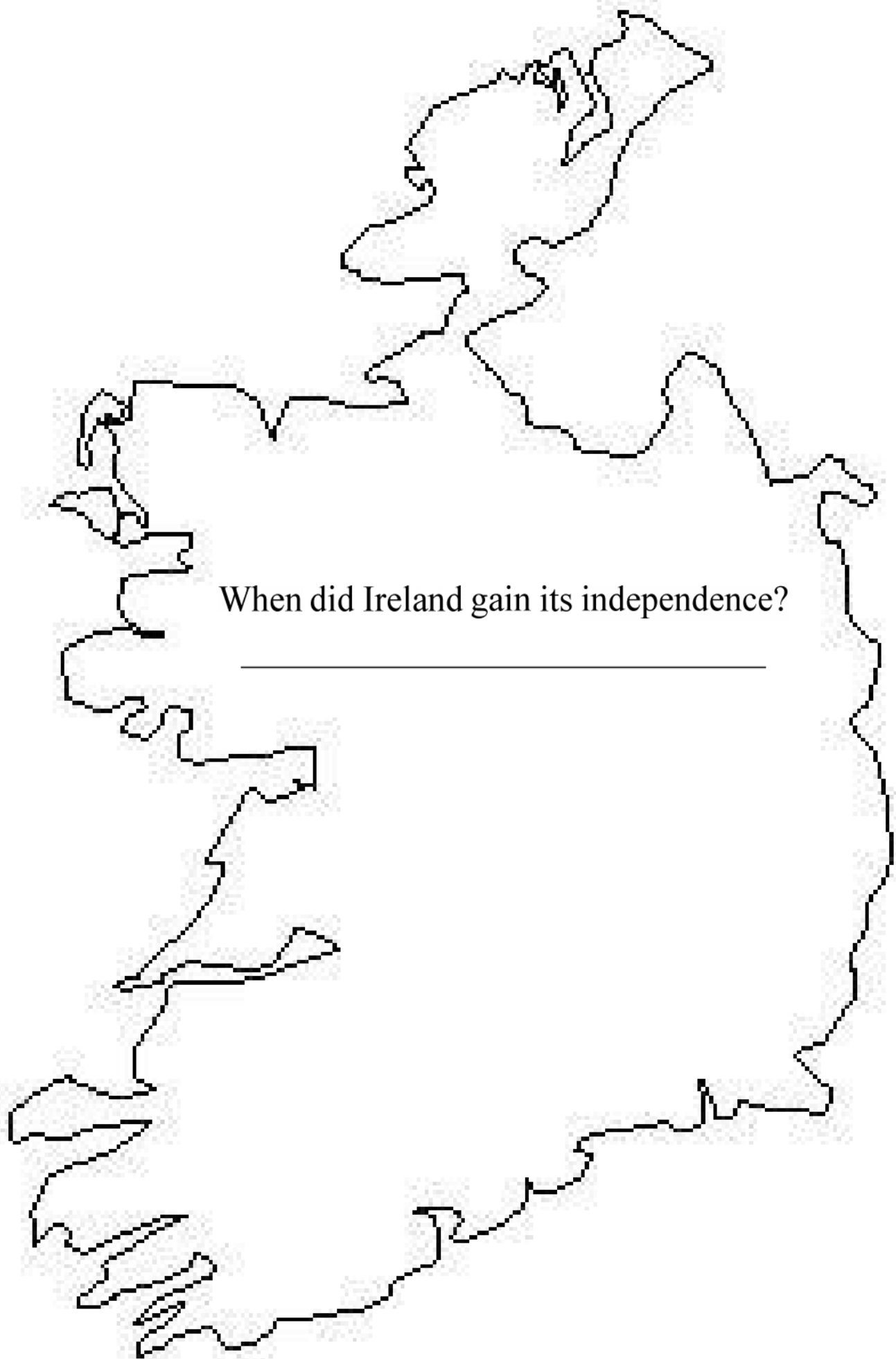
